

COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

2. Term

3. Warranties and representations

- iv. The Work does not infringe the legal rights of any person or persons including any existing copyright or trademark to the best of Author’s knowledge.

- vi. Author shall not create any third party rights in the Work, whether by way of a license or assignment.

4. Indemnity
