PROGRAMME DURATION AND SCHEDULE

The Course will be conducted from **25th July 2026 to 31st October 2026** in online mode on MS Teams Platform. Fourteen (14) Sessions will be of 3 hours duration and will be held every **Saturday from 10.00 am to 1.30 pm** (with a break of 30 minutes)

PEDAGOGY

Inputs will be delivered in English by industry experts and faculty members of NIA. Depending upon the need, industry experts may use a variety of pedagogical methods that may include lectures, presentations, case study, discussion, assignment and exercises.

EXAMINATION DETAILS

Final Exam for the course will be announced during the programme and would be for a duration of 100 minutes for 100 marks. Candidates need to secure 60% in the Final Exam to be eligible to receive the '**Diploma in Reinsurance**' from NIA. Candidates who fail to obtain 60% marks may re-appear in the examination on payment of Rs **1750+GST**. Accordingly, the dates for the re-exam will be announced later.

Batch size is 100. Admission is on a first-come, first-served basis.

The candidates will be emailed a link each week to participate in the session online once payment confirmation has been received.

The candidate will receive the "**Diploma in Reinsurance**" from NIA after successfully completing all the requirements of the Course and passing the Final Examination on securing a minimum of 60%.
